Re: [REDACTED] v. [REDACTED] domestic violence restraining-order packet

Dear Ms. [REDACTED],

We looked through the documents you sent us. A few items appear worth checking before anything is filed or signed, so we listed them below in the order that may be most helpful.

Here are the items that may be worth checking before the documents are filed or signed:

- On FW-001, page 1, the telephone number appears as [REDACTED PHONE], while DV-100, page 1, and CLETS-001, page 2, appear to use [REDACTED PHONE]. Please check which number is intended and make the entries consistent so the court can contact you at the correct number.
- The protected person's last name appears as "[REDACTED]" on DV-100, page 3, but as "[REDACTED]" on DV-100, page 6, DV-110, page 1, and CLETS-001, page 2. Please check the intended spelling and use it consistently so the witness and protected-person entries clearly identify the same person.
- The protected person's age appears different on DV-100, page 6, and DV-110, page 1; CLETS-001, page 2, lists a redacted birth date. Please check the intended age and make the entries consistent so the protected-person information matches across the forms.
- The signature date on FW-001, page 1, appears to be 7-22-26, which is later than the 7-13-2026 date on DV-100 and later than the date of this letter. Please check whether the FW-001 date was entered as intended so the packet does not appear to contain a future-dated signature.
- DV-100, page 13, item 32 appears blank even though 33 pages follow the 13-page form, including Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2. Please check the intended extra-page count and enter it if appropriate so the attachment total matches the packet.
- The exhibit material on merged DV-100 pages 15 through 46 appears mostly sideways, including text-message screenshots and photographs. Rotating the pages to a readable upright position may reduce viewing and processing confusion.
- Many of the photographs on merged DV-100 pages 18 through 46 do not appear to include captions, dates, or individual exhibit-page labels explaining what each image is meant to show. Please check whether short labels or page identifiers should be added so the exhibit sequence is easier to follow.
- On DV-100, page 3, item 5(e), none of the boxes for whether the police came appears selected. Please check the intended response and mark the appropriate box so the incident section does not appear incomplete.

- The narrative on DV-100, page 3, appears to contain several proofreading items, including "peoples devices," "multiples times," and "Every to every other day." Please check whether these should read "people's devices," "multiple times," and clearer wording for the frequency.
- The restrained person's address on DV-110, page 1, appears as "[REDACTED ADDRESS]," which may repeat the directional "S." Please check the intended street address so it is clear and accurate.
- CLETS-001, page 1, appears to list a driver's-license number without a state even though the field asks for both the number and state. Please check whether the state should be added so the identification entry is complete.
- CLETS-001, page 1, appears to list "[REDACTED ALIAS]" and "[REDACTED ALIAS]" as other names used, while DV-100, DV-109, and DV-110 appear to use only the primary restrained-person name. Please check whether any alternate-name wording should be carried consistently to other intended identification entries.
- The firearm-information line on DV-110, page 1, appears blank, while DV-100, page 6, and CLETS-001, page 1, appear to select "I don't know." Please check whether the DV-110 entry should match the information used on the companion forms.
- The case-name fields on FW-001, page 1, and FW-003, page 1, appear blank. Please check whether the short case name should be entered before submission so the fee-waiver papers can be matched to the same packet.
- The FW-003 footer appears to carry a September 1, 2019 revision date, while the companion FW-001 is dated March 1, 2026. The older date may be worth checking with the filer, court clerk, or a licensed attorney to confirm that the intended version is included.
- CLETS-001 is marked confidential and says not to place it in the court file, while the merged DV-100 exhibits include close-up injury images and photographs of home interiors. Please check that CLETS-001 is handled separately as indicated on the form and that all sensitive exhibit images are intended for the copies being filed or served.

P.S. I thought a checklist might help you, so I've added one at no extra charge.

[REDACTED] v. [REDACTED] – Checklist

- [] Check which telephone number is intended and make it consistent on FW-001, DV-100, and CLETS-001.
- [] Check whether the protected person's last name should be [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] and make the spelling consistent throughout the packet.
- [] Check the protected person's intended age against the redacted birth date and make DV-100 and DV-110 consistent.
- [] Check whether the 7-22-26 signature date on FW-001 was entered as intended.
- [] Check the number of extra pages attached to DV-100 and complete item 32 if appropriate.
- [] Rotate the exhibit pages and images to an upright, readable position.
- [] Check whether the exhibit photographs should include captions, dates, or individual page labels.
- [] Check the intended response to DV-100 item 5(e) and select the appropriate box.
- [] Proofread the DV-100 page 3 narrative, including the phrases "peoples devices," "multiples times," and "Every to every other day."
- [] Check whether the restrained person's DV-110 street address should contain both uses of "S."
- [] Check whether the driver's-license state should be added on CLETS-001.
- [] Check whether the restrained person's alternate names should be reflected consistently in the intended identification entries.
- [] Check whether the DV-110 firearm-information line should match the "I don't know" entries on DV-100 and CLETS-001.
- [] Check whether the case name should be entered on FW-001 and FW-003 before submission.
- [] Check with the filer, court clerk, or a licensed attorney whether the 2019 revision of FW-003 is the intended companion form.
- [] Check the separate handling of CLETS-001 and whether all sensitive exhibit images are intended for filing or service copies.
