We looked through the documents you sent us. A few items appear worth checking before anything is filed or signed, so we listed them below in the order that may be most helpful.

Here are the items that may be worth checking before the documents are filed or signed:

- Request to Enter Default, page 1, and FL-170, page 1, appear to describe the property paperwork differently. The Request to Enter Default says the Property Declaration is not attached and checks reasons suggesting there are no property issues for the court to decide, while FL-170 says community or quasi-community assets and debts are listed in a completed current Property Declaration and will be divided in the proposed judgment. The packet may be clearer if the intended selections are checked for consistency before filing.
- The proposed Property Order Attachment to Judgment, page 1, appears to list the same 2019 Ford Mustang as property the petitioner will receive and property the respondent will receive. It also lists a reimbursement claim for the petitioner. Please check which entries are intended so the vehicle and reimbursement wording do not appear to conflict.
- The proposed Judgment, page 1, checks that the marriage will end on a specified date, but the date line appears blank. This may create a completion question, so the intended date entry may be worth checking before the proposed judgment is submitted.
- The proposed Judgment, page 2, indicates that property division is ordered through an attached Property Order Attachment, but the 'Number of pages attached' line appears

blank. Because the packet includes a two-page property attachment, the stated attachment count may be worth checking for consistency.

- The Request to Enter Default, page 1, says a completed Property Declaration is not attached, but the proposed judgment packet includes property orders describing a vehicle and a reimbursement claim. Even if the Property Declaration is being handled separately, the packet may be clearer if the attachment selections and included documents are checked against the final filing set.
- The Notice of Entry of Judgment contains blank judgment-entry, date, clerk, and mailing-certificate fields. Some of these areas may be intended for court use, but the filer may wish to confirm that the correct version is included and that no filer-completed entry has been overlooked.
- Several documents display the client's street address, telephone number, email address, and the respondent's mailing address. These details may be sensitive, so it may be worth checking with the filer, court clerk, or a licensed attorney whether the copies intended for public filing or broader service should contain all of that information.

- ☐ Check whether the Property Declaration and property-issue selections on the Request to Enter Default and FL-170 should be made consistent.
- ☐ Check which party should receive the 2019 Ford Mustang and whether the reimbursement wording is intended.
- ☐ Check whether the proposed Judgment should include a date for termination of marital status.
- ☐ Check whether the number of pages attached to the proposed Judgment should be entered.
- ☐ Check whether the attachment selections on the Request to Enter Default match the final filing packet.
- ☐ Check whether the correct Notice of Entry of Judgment version is included and whether any filer-completed fields remain blank.
- ☐ Check whether sensitive contact and address information should remain visible on public or broadly served copies.
